5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES:**General information****Suitable (and unsuitable) extinguishing media**

- Suitable extinguishing media** : Water Foam Carbon dioxide (CO₂) Dry powder

Absorb spill with vermiculite or other inert material, then place in a container for chemical waste. Clean surface thoroughly to remove residual contamination. Dike far ahead of larger spill for later recovery and disposal.
- Notification Procedures** : Prevent entry into waterways, sewer, basements or confined areas. Inform authorities if large amounts are involved.
- Environmental precautions** : Do not contaminate water sources or sewer. Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. Avoid discharge into drains, water courses or onto the ground.

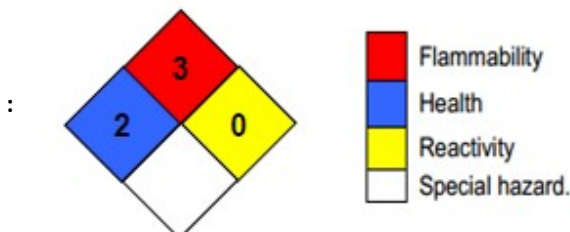
