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Hazard statement	: Harmful if swallowed. Causes skin irritation. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause respiratory irritation. Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

Evacuate the danger area, observe emergency procedures, consult an expert.**Methods and material for containment and cleaning up** : Eliminate all ignition sources if safe to do so. Use only non-sparking tools. Take precautionary measures against static discharges. Stop leak if possible without any risk. Absorb spill with vermiculite or other inert material, then place in a container for chemical waste. Clean surface thoroughly to remove residual contamination. Dike far ahead of larger spill for later recovery and disposal.**Notification Procedures** : Prevent entry into waterways, sewer, basements or confined areas. 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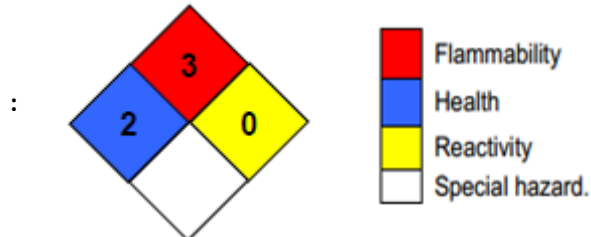
